AMVETS National Americanism Essay Contest Rules

Who can participate?

All students in the 6th, 7th, 8th, 9th, 10th, 11th and 12th grades that attend public, private or parochial schools are eligible to enter.

Annual Themes:

2018 - 2019 "Why should you say 'Thank You' to a Veteran?"

2019 - 2020 "What does freedom mean to me?"

2020 - 2021 "What do I think of when I see the American flag?"

2021 - 2022 "Why should we honor and respect our Veterans?"

Contest Rules:

- All students must **address the theme**.
- All essays may be written in ink, typed or produced on a computer.
- **6th Grade** Students should submit essays of **200 words or less**.
- **7th & 8th Grade** students should submit essays of **300 words or less**.
- **9th & 10th Grade** students should submit essays of **400 words or less**.
- **11th & 12th Grade** students should submit essays of **500 words or less**.
- All national entries must be postmarked by July 1. Local and state deadlines may vary.
