

Easterseals Western and Central Pennsylvania is excited to announce our new afterschool initiative, sponsored by the Thomas L. Cline Foundation. This program is specifically designed for those with special needs in grades 3 through 8 and is set to begin in January, operating every Tuesday and Thursday from immediately after school to 6:00PM at Conewago Township Elementary School. Transportation is available from from the following districts and may be open to others as enrollment becomes available: Conewago Valley, Littlestown, Bermudian and Gettysburg.

Activities will include arts and crafts, cooperative games, special guest presentations, team building activities, exercise to build socialization and much, much more.

Easterseals provides trained, professional, and caring staff at a ratio of 1:4 (minimum counselor to participant ratio). This allows us to give our participants individualized attention while encouraging independence at the same time. Individuals requiring more care than a 1:4 ratio are required to have a non-parental support person over the age of 18 at the program. These cases are handled individually, please contact us for more information.

**When?** Beginning in January – every Tuesday and Thursday, afterschool until 6:00PM

**Where?** Conewago Township Elementary School

**Who?** Children, grades 3-8 with special needs

**Cost?** \$10 per evening – must register for entire month (as an example, January would total \$90 for 9 evenings)
