CALLIGRAPHIC LETTERING BASICS WORKSHOP

It requires some skill and practice to handle the edged pen that creates the thick and thin strokes, and therefore the construction of pen-made letters should be studied first with a pair of double pencils (the twin points represent the pen's edge). The double pencils make an outline drawing of letters that has the advantage of showing clearly how strokes unite that is not obvious with the solid form made with the pen. Students will learn good proportion in letters, maintaining a consistent angle to form letters, and establish a good basis for a variety of letterforms. Sue Ann has taught Lettering and Calligraphy at the Baltimore School for the Arts and University of Maryland, Baltimore Campus. **Please contact the Guild for supply list.**
