### **Pre-School:**

#### **Ballerinas & Bears, June 22-26, 9-11 a.m., ages 4-5**

Beginner ballerinas and bears learn ballet basics and movement, wear their favorite costumes, and have a dancing teddy bear party. This gentle intro to learning simple, combined movements includes a mini performance at the end of the camp week showing the moves they learned and the fun they had.

### **Fiber Arts:**

#### **Creative Weaving, June 8-12, 9:30 a.m.-12:30 p.m., ages 9-12, maximum enrollment: 8**

**Perspective Drawing Camp, June 29-July 3, 9 a.m.-12 p.m., ages 11-14**

Spend a week learning to melt and fuse powdered glass onto metal with a special firing process using an enameling kiln. Vitreous enameling is an age-old process that uses techniques like sifting, stenciling, painting, sgraffito, and photo transfer to create a variety of imaginative projects.
