Dear Parents/Guardians:

Welcome to New Oxford Elementary School's Summer Reading Program! Reading is the most important lifelong skill that we can help our children to learn and to practice. Research indicates that the amount of time children spend reading is one of the best predictors of their success as readers.

Our Goal: To encourage students to read for pleasure and continue to build their reading skills in order to become lifelong readers.

Expectations:

- ³⁵/₁₇ Read 10 books with your child.
- ³⁵/₁₇ Complete a reading log entry for each book.
- ³⁵/₁₇ Complete one picture and one sentence for each book read.
- ³⁵/₁₇ Parents are encouraged to read aloud to and with their children.
- ³⁵/₁₇ For every 5 books read, logged and the pictures/sentences completed, you may bring them to NOE on the following dates for a reward: Wed., July 10 and Th., Aug. 15 from 8:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. Rewards include books and certificates to local restaurants and entertainment.
